

A Report on the Observance of the First Death Anniversary of Zubeen Garg

Date: 19th September, 2026

Beltola College observed with sorrow and gloom the first death anniversary of Zubeen Garg, Heartthrob of Assam, on 19th September 2026. The programme, which was hosted by Sujata Buragohain, Assistant professor Department of Political Science, started at 11:00 am with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp by Dr Jayanta Barman, the principal of the college. A host of students, including Beltola College Students Union and all Faculty Members along with Non-Teaching Staff participated in the programme. The inaugural speech was delivered by Principal Dr Jayanta Burman. He highlighted the greatness of the most popular singer of Assam, his act as a good human being and as a social worker. Among the faculty members Dr Mrigendranath Sharma HOD, and Assistant Professors in the Department of Assamese, and Dr Lina Dekka, HOD and Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science, spoke about the life and work and numerous causes of popularity of Zubeen Garg including his humanitarian nature, sacrifice for the poor. In the programme students performed songs of Zubeen Garg and danced to the songs of Zubeen Garg. Among the staff, Mofida Begum, Bornali Mohan, Himanshu Das, Himadree Kumar Sarmah, Dorin Moholia sang some immortal songs of Zubeen Garg. The program came to close at 1:00 p.m. after the common performance by all the students and staff the song “*Mayabini*”, the most favourite song of Zubeen Garg.
